

**TOWNSHIP OF ELDRED
MONROE COUNTY, PENNSLVANIA**

EXTENSION OF DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2026, the Supervisors of the Township of Eldred, in anticipation of a significant Snow Storm to occur in Eldred Township, signed a Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency is set to expire on Monday February 23, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service and other weather forecasting services have forecasted a significant Snow Storm (the “February Snow Storm”) to occur in Eldred Township during the approximate period of February 22, 2026 to February 23, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the February Snow Storm, and its possible consequences, threatens to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and property in the Township of Eldred (the “Township”); and

WHEREAS, the February Snow Storm, and its possible consequences, constitute a threat of imminent disaster and danger to the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in the Township and threatens to create problems greater in scope than problems the Township may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS, this threat of imminent disaster and emergency has the potential to cause significant adverse impacts upon the population throughout the Township; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of endangered residents in the Township.

NOW THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Supervisors of the Township of Eldred pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA C.S., Section 7501), as amended, do hereby extend the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency in the Township of Eldred for a period of seven (7) days (through and including Monday, March 2, 2026) due to the forecasted February Snow Storm.

FURTHER, and consistent with the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency, we direct the Township Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, and to take any other emergency response actions deemed necessary to respond to this emergency.

STILL FURTHER, and consistent with the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency, we authorize officials of the Township to act as necessary to meet the current exigencies of this emergency, without regard to time-consuming procedures and formalities prescribed by law (excepting mandatory constitutional requirements) pertaining to the performance of public work,

entering into contracts, the incurring of obligations, the employment of temporary workers, the rental of equipment, the purchase of supplies and materials, the levying of taxes and the appropriation and expenditure of public funds.

This Extension of Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency shall extend the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency executed on January 23, 2026 through and including Monday, March 2, 2026.
